Timu Eco-Camp is located on the East African Rift escapement at an altitude of 2,000m. The location offers a breathtaking view of the surrounding landscape, amidst the indigenous ik community.

Morungole Eco-Camp is a historical resting place for the hunters-gatherers community and is located at the foot of Mount Morungole. It's located in the midst of the woodland and offers access to the summit using ancestral trails.

10% CONSERVATION LEVY

Pressure on consumption of biodiversity is reduced through creating value of their ecosystem. Each guests contributes towards the conservation of the surrounding environment through a so-called 'conservation levy' of 10% on top of the bed-night fee. This fee supports local organised groups with their conservation activities.

OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

The Ik tribe are former hunters gatherers and today live on the extreme northeastern corner of the country. They are known for their love for the environment and their cultural heritage.

You will find stunningly beautiful Scenery the higher your climb takes you, simply breathtaking scenes in the valleys below you and into the Eastern Rift Valley of Kenya and over to Southern Sudan.

- Payments can be done via Credit Card with a transaction fee of 3.5% (Mastercard, VISA and American Express).

THE GENESIS

With the matching grant from USAID/RTI Biodiversity for Resilience Activity, through its Strategic Investment Fund, Kara-Tunga launched two Eco-Camps in September 2022.

The camps are located at the farthest end of the north-eastern corner of Uganda in Kaabong District. The Morungole and Timu Eco Camps provide attractive new domestic and international tourism destinations for travelers who seek off-the-beaten-path, immersive cultural experiences, and wilderness adventures. A third eco-camp is set to open in 2023 south of Kidepo Valley National Park.

Kara-Tunga has recruited and trained 30 campsite staff, and eleven cultural groups, all from the Ik communities in Morungole and Timu. Through these efforts, not only will tourists have a more comfortable and exciting experience in this part of the country, but they will bring much needed revenue to the surrounding communities and strengthen conservation of the unique landscape.


